

The <u>Wellbeing After Stroke Program</u> aims to provide an educational series based on cognitive behavioral therapy techniques for managing mental and emotional wellbeing of individuals who have experienced Stroke. The program consists of 6 core lessons to help clients gain skills to manage their thoughts, behaviors, and physical symptoms resulting from post-stroke depression and/or anxiety.

# The TRAIL Trial Community-based Tele-rehabilitation



The TRAIL trial, which was run on the CanStroke platform, studied the feasibility of a progressive virtual exercise and self-management intervention in individuals with stroke, using video-conferencing technology.

<u>Check out the results</u> that show this approach appears to have positive influences on mobility, lower extremity impairment, strength, and goal attainment when delivered under the guidance of trained clinicians when social support and program resources are available.

These types of programs can prolong the continuum of care that individuals receive once they are discharged back into the community.

# Stroke news shared at the International Stroke Conference 2024



#### Lying Flat Shows Big Benefit in Large Vessel Occlusion (LVO) Stroke

Patients with acute ischemic stroke who have LVO have shown an impressive benefit from having their head lowered to a flat position until they are able to undergo thrombectomy in a new landmark randomized clinical trial.

#### Vagal Nerve Stimulation in Stroke: Benefit Out to 1 Year

Use of vagal nerve stimulation in combination with intense physical rehabilitation in patients with chronic stroke led to improved hand and arm function, with benefits maintained out to 1 year

#### Ginkgo Injections Tied to Cognitive Recovery Post Stroke

A combination of biologically active components of Ginkgo biloba given by intravenous (IV) injection for 14 days was associated with improved early cognitive recovery in patients with acute ischemic stroke.

#### Hypertension Before 35 Tied to Triple Stroke Risk in Midlife

Black women who develop high blood pressure before age 35 have a threefold increased risk of having a midlife stroke, new observational data suggested



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
