In addition to tests listed on Practitioner Schedule D, Registered Nurses and Registered Psychiatric Nurses may also refer for medically required non fee-for-service insured laboratory medicine tests approved within the Registered Nurses' and Registered Psychiatric Nurses' scope of practice in communicable disease management and prevention.

This list is not approved but provides guidance to support the determination of ordering appropriate testing and subsequent interpretation and management within the scope of practice.
